I acquired my first purebred dog, an Irish Setter, in 1971 and my foundation Doberman Pinscher in early 1973.

Under the Freespirits kennel name I have bred over 100 Canadian and American Champions, many of which were also Group and Best in Show winners. Four different Freespirits Dobermans have placed in the top two rankings for all breeds in Canada over the years and Freespirits Far And Away was Canada's Top Dog of all breeds in 2001.

From the early 1980's through 1996 I handled all breeds of dogs professionally and was blessed to win at the top level with many different breeds.

I began my judging career in 1998 and am currently licensed to judge six complete groups. I have judged many Specialties and All Breed Shows across North America.

Still showing our own dogs on a limited basis, my husband and I share our home with three Dutch bred Salukis, a retired Doberman and a Papillon.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES CLASS

The Sweepstakes classes are open to all dogs from 6 months to under 18 months regardless of their place of birth. Dogs **MUST** also be entered in one of the regular classes at this Specialty.

Classes (divided by sex **ONLY**) offered as follows:
6 to 9 mths Male/Female, 9 to 12 mths Male/Female,
12 to 18 mths Male/Female

Rosettes and a cash award will be awarded for 1st in all classes. In addition, a Rosette will be offered to Best in Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. All monies received for the entry of the Sweepstake will be pooled and divided as follows:

Best in Sweepstakes: 25% of total entry fees received
Best of Opposite Sex: 20% of total entry fees received
1st in each Class: 5% of total entry fees received

25% of all Sweepstakes money collected retained by Club to defray costs.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASS

The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs 7 years of age and over, regardless of their place of birth. Classes will be divided by sex as follows:

7 to 10 years Male/Female
10 years and over Male/Female

Rosettes and a cash award will be awarded for 1st in all classes. In addition, a Rosette will be offered to Best Veteran in Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex Veteran in Sweepstakes. The remainder of Veterans in Sweeps will receive a participant Rosette. All monies received for the entry of the Sweepstake will be pooled and divided as follows:

Best Veteran in Sweepstakes: 25% of total entry fees received
Best of Opposite Sex: 20% of total entry fees received
1st in each Class: 5% of total entry fees received

25% of all Sweepstakes money collected retained by Club to defray costs

TROPHIES and ROSETTES

A suitable trophy and rosette will be offered for the following awards:

BEST OF BREED, BEST OPPOSITE SEX, BEST OF WINNERS, BEST PUPPY, WINNERS MALE and FEMALE, RESERVE WINNERS MALE and FEMALE, VETERAN MALE, VETERAN FEMALE, BEST STUD DOG, BEST BROOD MATRON, BEST CANADIAN-BRED, BEST VETERAN, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR WINNERS ALTERED MALE and FEMALE, BEST ALTERED IN BREED, BEST OPPOSITE SEX ALTERED IN BREED,

ROSETTES ONLY WILL BE OFFERED TO ALL FIRST through FOURTH PLACEMENTS IN ALL REGULAR CLASSES.

JUDGES' AWARDS OF MERIT ROSETTE will be presented at the judges' discretion (1 award per 10 dogs competing for Best of Breed)

***BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN SPECIALTY** (*award must come from the Bred By class)

***BEST CANADIAN BRED IN SPECIALTY** (* award may come from any class)

BEST VETERAN IN SPECIALTY (*award will be made from the winners of the Veteran Male and Veteran Female class)

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered classes shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes ONLY will be offered
Altered Male and Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog *6 months of age and under 9 months of age* on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog *9 months of age and under 12 months of age* on the day of the show

12 to 18 MONTH CLASS - For dogs *12 months & under 18 months* on the day of this Show

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada.

(Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. **Note:** A Listed dog **MAY** be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class **MUST** be received by the Show Secretary **ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED.** Listing Fees **WILL NOT** be refunded

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class **MAY NOT COMPETE** in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

ADDITIONAL CONFORMATION SPECIALTY CLASSIFICATIONS

The following additional regular/non-regular classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

VETERANS CLASS - For dogs 7 years of age and older on the day of this Show. *Dogs entered in this class DO NOT COMPETE FOR POINTS but rather the winner of the Veteran Male & Veteran Female Class go directly onto the Best of Breed competition.*

UNOFFICIAL/NON-REGULAR CLASSES

All dogs to be entered in any unofficial/non-regular class **MUST** also be entered in an official class or for Exhibition Only

SIRE & GET - Entry into this class shall comprise the Sire and two or more of his Get (**Note: Get MUST be entered in a regular class**)

DAM & PROGENY - Shall have all the same requirements as the Sire & Get Class (**Note: Progeny MUST be entered in a regular class**)
